

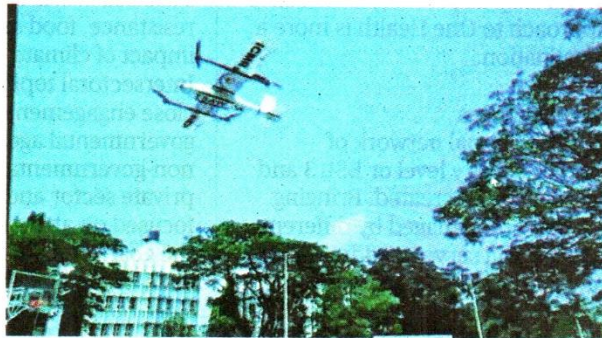
Drones to help transport mid-surgery tissue samples for pathological testing

A medical sample – onco-pathological tissue – was transported mid-surgery using a drone from Dr. TMA Pai Rotary Hospital in Karkala to Kasturba Hospital in Manipal in Udupi district of Karnataka on Wednesday.

The Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE), Manipal, and the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) joined together in this initiative of an aerial healthcare delivery system using drones.

The initiative aims to utilise drones for transporting onco-pathological samples between peripheral and tertiary care hos-

pitals in Karnataka, a release from from Kasturba Hospital said.

Meanwhile, an ICMR post in X said: "Next milestone achieved in healthcare delivery via drone! Tissue sample transported mid-surgery from a peripheral hospital to advanced

pathological testing at tertiary setting for deciding if the resected issue is cancerous or not."

It said that the drone service reduced the travel time between the two towns (Karkala and Manipal) from 60 minutes to 16 minutes.

"Reducing the time from 60 minutes to 16 minutes (37 km), this innovative approach would enable faster decisions during surgery and improved access to high-level healthcare for patients in peripheral hospitals," ICMR said on X.

The release said the primary objective of this initiative is to assess the feasibility of transferring materials, such as frozen section samples from remote locations to peripheral hospitals using aerial means. This endeavour is expected to enhance the healthcare system by enabling surgeons to perform procedures requiring such investigations in rural areas, it said.

Udupi, Apr 10: Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) and Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE) have collaborated to launch innovative Aerial Healthcare Delivery Programme.

A groundbreaking collaboration between the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) and Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE) has led to the inception of the deployment of a RObust NEed based aerial healthcare delivery system (DRONE). This programme aims to introduce the use of drones for transporting onco-pathological samples between





The primary focus of this initiative is to evaluate the feasibility of transferring bio-specimen, such as frozen section samples, from remote locations to peripheral hospitals using aerial transportation. The ultimate goal is to enhance the healthcare infrastructure by enabling surgeons to conduct procedures that require such investigations in rural areas.

Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs), commonly referred to as drones, have been increasingly embraced across various sectors, including healthcare. The i-DRONE project seeks to investigate the feasibility and utility of employing drones for this purpose. By harnessing drone technology, tissue samples can be transported swiftly, offering immediate access to advanced diagnostics like Frozen sections during surgical procedures. Successful implementation of this research could potentially transform healthcare delivery by establishing seamless connections between remote hospitals and laboratory facilities, thereby facilitating complex surgeries for patients in geographically isolated regions.

The inauguration ceremony witnessed the presence of esteemed dignitaries and scientists including Dr Rajiv Bahl, Secretary, department of health research, government of India and director general, ICMR, who served as the chief guest. 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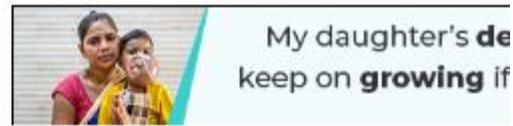
